Web Accessibility Statement

Under the Government's new Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018, Midridge Parish Council are required to publish a Web Accessibility Statement on their Website, indicating whether it is fully, partially or not compliant with these Regulations.

Midridge Parish Council has had a Website for a long time, but although the content is regularly updated, the software we use dates back to well before the advent of Smartphones, and thus most of this Website is almost certainly **NOT COMPLIANT** with the new Regulations.

Unfortunately upgrading the Website to comply with the new Regulations is a major undertaking, for which we will require outside help, and is likely to prove a substantial cost to our limited financial resources. Consequently, whilst the Parish Council are working urgently to develop a plan for updating this Website, this is likely to take some time, and in the interim we ask you to be patient.

In the meantime, if you are unable to access information you require from the Website in the way you would wish due to technical difficulties, two alternatives are:-
